Depuis ses débuts en 2016, le TalentLAB promeut l'esprit d'échange, de dialogue et d'ouverture. Richard Twyman took up the role of Artistic Director of ETT (English Touring Theatre) in November 2016. He was previously Associate Director (International) at the Royal Court Theatre, where he worked with playwrights across the world to develop their plays. Prior to this, he spent five years at the Royal Shakespeare Company working on fourteen productions including the critically acclaimed and Olivier Award-winning Histories Cycle.

AKRAM KHAN

Chorégraphe

Akram Khan is one of the most celebrated and respected dance artists of today. In just over 22 years he has created a body of work that has contributed significantly to the arts in the UK and abroad. His reputation has been built on the success of imaginative, highly accessible and relevant productions such as *Giselle*, *Jungle Book reimagined*, *Outwitting the Devil*, *XENOS*, *Until the Lions*, *Kaash*, *iTMOi* (*in the mind of igor*), *DESH*, *Vertical Road*, *Gnosis* and *zero degrees*.

Khan has been the recipient of numerous awards throughout his career including the Laurence Olivier Award, the Bessie Award and the prestigious ISPA Distinguished Artist Award. He was awarded an MBE for services to dance in 2005. A longterm collaboration links Akram to the Théâtres de la Ville de Luxembourg with many of his works coproduced and presented here such as *Giselle* in 2019 or *iTMOi* in 2014.



ALEXANDRA LACROIX

Metteuse en scène

Alexandra Lacroix a étudié à l'École nationale supérieure des arts décoratifs de Paris. Elle cofonde la Cie MPDA dont elle assure la direction artistique. Elle y recherche une nouvelle façon d'appréhender les œuvres, le rapport au public et la mise en corps des musicien.ne.s. Elle conçoit le livret et la mise en scène de *The Carmen Case* (Diana Soh et Georges Bizet, dir. Lucie Leguay, 2023) et de *Be My Superstar, a contemporary tragedy* (Simon Vosecek, 2019) en collaboration avec le réseau enoa. Les deux projets sont coproduits et présentés par les Théâtres de la Ville de Luxembourg. En 2024, elle crée *Belboul* de Jules Massenet et *Des rires au jasmin* de Farnaz Modarresifar à l'Opéra de Reims et reprend *Sur un nuage* au Théâtre de l'Aquarium – Cartoucherie de Paris. Marraine opéra du TalentLAB et régulièrement invitée à donner des conférences et master-class dans des institutions telles que le CNSMDP, l'EHESS, la Fondation Royaumont, la White Chapel Gallery, la Philharmonie de Paris, le Centre Georges Pompidou, Alexandra s'engage et participe aux réflexions sur l'Opéra, ses nouveaux récits et ses nouvelles formes.

POUR UNE VIE MEILLEURE

by Carlota Maria De Matos e Silva / UK

Carlota Matos is a Portuguese theatre and performance artist based in Bristol, UK. She works internationally with communities, young people and artists, focusing on access and social change. With a background in physical theatre, her practice often explores themes of migration, identity and mental ill-health. Carlota is interested in making professional live work with people who are not necessarily trained or experienced performers, in the form of documentary theatre or participatory performances. She is dedicated to breaking down barriers and increasing representation in theatre, especially for migrants and disabled people.

PROJECT PRESENTATION

Pour une vie meilleure portrays the lives of Portuguese immigrants and their descendants today. In light of the 50th anniversary of the Carnation Revolution and inspired by the work of photographer Gérald Bloncourt, who documented Portuguese migration between 1954 and 1974, this project will explore people's memories from the Salazar dictatorship, the life journeys that brought them to live in another country, and second / third-generation migrants' connection to their families' origins. The piece will not only explore the historical context but delve into the complexities of migration, identity, belonging and collective history. It will test how documentation can be used on stage, crossing art forms and experimenting with visual narratives.

HOLLANDA

by Avildseen Bheekhoo / FR

Avildseen Bheekhoo is a Mauritian artist and storyteller who makes fiction and reality communicate through immersive experiences. He designs quirky experiments around cinematographic fictions that he models into real-life experiences involving performing arts and public interaction via a process he dubs as Real Virtuality in order to bring additional audiences to arthouse and international cinema. In 2022, he had the opportunity to work with the Grand Théâtre de la Ville de Luxembourg on *Voices of the City*, in the context of the Luxembourg presidency of the Quattropole network, to present his vision of the town of Trier.

PROJECT PRESENTATION

Hollanda is a theatre performance inspired by the Mauritian myth of “Touni Minwi”, a sketchy werewolf that terrorized the inhabitants during a ten-day power blackout in 1994. Set in an apocalyptic future, the aim is to reveal the backstage secrets of this paradise island, explore its communities and their art of drawing on television fictions to confront harsh realities. We want to cast an unyielding gaze upon the shadows plaguing these shores: racism, hypocrisy, repressed sexuality and the inability to find a common identity and, while shining a light on those shadows born of the echoes of colonial legacies, we also want to explore how generative AI and deepfakes will radically distort our memories.

THE ABSURD HERO

by Malcolm Sutherland / UK

Born in Scotland, Malcolm trained at the Central School of Ballet in London. He spent 7 years with Staatstheater Nürnberg performing in works from: Kylian, Duato, Naharin, Ek, Inger & Pite, etc. Malcolm has created numerous works for stage, including 3 full-length productions for the Tafelhalle. Further works include: *Greed* (Theater St Gallen), *Entrails of a Wildcat* (Nephrite, Japan), *Lost for Words* (Resolution), *Shelf Life* (Interdans), *Imagined Orders* (DAF) & *Aftermath* (Resid'AND). He has been a lead artist on the Cohan Collective & on Magnetic North's Rough Mix programme as well as completing his MA Choreography with distinction.

PROJECT PRESENTATION

The Absurd Hero is a dance theatre work which draws inspiration from Albert Camus' philosophical essay, *The Myth of Sisyphus*, which delves into an existential dilemma central to the human experience. The Absurd refers to the conflict between the human tendency to seek inherent value and meaning in life, and the human inability to find any in a purposeless, meaningless or chaotic and irrational universe. The universe and the human mind do not each separately cause the Absurd, but rather, it arises by the contradictory nature of the two existing simultaneously. Camus claims that Sisyphus is the ideal absurd hero so long as he accepts that there is nothing more to life than this absurd struggle, then he can attempt to find happiness within it.

BETWEEN HERE AND THERE FROM CONFLICT TO CHOREOGRAPHY

Maher Abdul Moaty is a Syrian-German choreographer. His dance training is the foundation for his exploration of different forms of expression and movement. Maher's unique choreographic approach seamlessly blends tradition and modernity to create an original and captivating style. Actively involved in national and international dance projects, he creates thought-provoking pieces that address contemporary social issues. Committed to promoting intercultural dialogue, Maher believes in the unifying power of dance. Dynamic and spirited, his work embodies an intellectually stimulating exploration of the possibilities of human movement.

PROJECT PRESENTATION

Between Here and There explores post-war hope through poignant dance. The narratives of three war survivors are unfolded through sharing different cultures and struggles. Traditional music blends seamlessly with contemporary dance, amplifying voices and illuminating personal journeys. This project serves as a catalyst for empathy, exploring identity, the refugee experience and global crises. Research focuses on movement as a tool for expression, enhancing coordination and awareness. Real-life stories inspire the choreography, transforming personal narratives into a universal language. By demonstrating the resilience of the human spirit and promoting hope and identity in the face of conflict, the work bridges worlds.

EAR TO EARTH

by Jenna Vergeynst / BE

Cusk is the co-creation collective of musicians / performers / scientists Jenna Vergeynst and Kristien Doumen, musician / performer Alex Smith and composer / field-recordist Ellen Jacobs. Our mission as a collective is to translate science artistically in the form of music theatre. Co-creation lies at the heart of our working process. We start the development of a performance with a scientific research period, followed by intense creation periods wherein we interpret and translate the collected material through music, theatre and movement. The scenes that emerge from this process, become the building blocks of the resulting performance.

PROJECT PRESENTATION

The earth, our living soil – the tiny surface layer of our globe – is what all earthly life depends on. It is the basis of our food production system and of biodiversity, it literally roots our living world, it produces clean water, stores carbon and regulates the climate. The worms, fungi, mites, springtails, and other life forms which live in the dark are essential for the survival of life above the ground, despite how unknown their world is to us. In this project, we want to connect to this lively darkness by giving it a voice. We will listen to the sounds of the soil using field recording devices adapted for this purpose. The music and movements inspired by these sounds, will be the fertile soil for a new performance.

YUM!

by April Koyejo-Audiger / UK

April Koyejo-Audiger is an opera singer / opera maker and a graduate of the Royal Conservatoire of Scotland, Royal College of Music and a former Link Artist (19-21) and Jette Parker Anniversary Company Artist (2021–22) for the Royal Opera House, London. As an opera-maker / librettist, her recently performed works include *Ayanfe* and *Bubbles the Zebrafish*. A new immersive recital / art installation – *The Duchess of Benin* – is in development. She was recently resident at the Festival d'Aix with *Our eyes looking for god*, adapted from the play *Caspers* by TD. Moyo. *Yum!* is co-created with composers Wen Liu and Jorge Ramos, part of the Studio M.A.R.S collective.

PROJECT PRESENTATION

Yum! is a mixed-reality opera and dining experience, where the audience becomes an essential element of the show. In a world where climate change has decimated and transformed our eating and dining habits, three self-obsessed individuals, immune to the tribulations of the masses, experience an evening designed only for the select few. The opera is an immersive, multi-sensory adventure, with audiences seated on stage amongst and surrounding the cast. *Yum!* blends satire and dark humour with social commentary to explore the themes of climate change, class, identity, and self-obsession, all in a blurred and ostentatious setting.

DANCE (work in progress):

Body that Stands (working title), Smadar Goshen.

Based on the fundamental assumption – that physical resistance is one of our most basic and necessary ‘habits’, which we must produce in order to manage our bodies on this planet – the piece explores multiple embodiments of physical resistance, observed in different cultures, groups and times.

What happens when four very different dancers decide to create something together? Do they have to become one for the show to be coherent, or is it rather the sum of the four individuals that makes the piece interesting? Vagabundus est une performance dans laquelle 13 interprètes ne cessent de danser et de chanter un répertoire musical mozambicain traditionnel et contemporain, sur la trame de motifs gospels et baroques. Le chorégraphe mozambicain Idio Chichava montre la migration à travers le prisme du corps. Souvent jugée volontaire ou forcée, elle est une vague invisible, un flux humain. Le migrant est le nomade d'aujourd'hui, le colon, le découvreur, mais aussi le vagabond. Pour construire la chorégraphie, il s'inspire du rituel de danse du peuple Makonde au Mozambique, qui par la fusion de la danse et du chant soutient l'expression d'un corps global.

In Miet Warlop's studio and imaginary world, everything is in constant motion. Components fuse together into one great swirling transformation. Characters and images from one production turn up in another. Sometimes they start to lead a life of their own. For instance, the elegant table from *Springville* – starched white tablecloth, elegant female legs in black tights and pumps – walked into a gallery and turned into an installation that functioned in its own right. Twelve years after the premiere, Warlop has taken the production up again as a memory that has to be relived or a song of her own that she wants to cover with a new group.
